

White Lightning Instructions For Recommended Use

Seedy toe and thrush are significant problems in equines throughout New Zealand.

White Lightning is a solution which, when activated, produces a gas which is very aggressive in neutralizing bacteria, fungus and yeast. It has been proven to be highly effective in the treatment of minor cases of seedy toe, white line disease and thrush in the hooves of horses.

The gases that are produced when activating White Lightning have been demonstrated to be bactericidal, fungicidal, virucidal and sporicidal while remaining harmless to healthy tissue.

Required materials for hoof soak

- White Lightning liquid
- White Vinegar
- Soak boot or bag (and duct tape if using a bag)
- Water

Instructions for use

These steps should be taken with the approval and/or assistance of your vet and hoof-care professional.

- Remove the shoes if necessary.
- For seedy toe or white line disease: carefully expose and remove the affected area of seedy toe. Use a hoof knife or Dremel tool as appropriate
- For thrush: carefully trim the affected area and remove excess frog with a hoof knife
- Thoroughly clean the whole hoof of dirt and debris

- Mix equal amount of White Lightning and white vinegar. To achieve the desired results, we recommend using the white vinegar which is labelled for use with White Lightning.
- Quantities: use $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ bottle of White Lightning (8oz bottle) per hoof depending on severity of the condition and size of the horse.
- Use the White Lightning Activation Bottle to measure equal amounts of White Lightning and white vinegar
- Once mixed, the solution remains active for up to 8 hours.
- Place the hoof in the soak boot
- Ensure the horse is settled with the boot in place. Standing the horse on grass or a soft surface will prevent damaging the soak boot.
- Place activated solution in the soak boot. Pour the solution carefully down the side of the boot rather than the leg of the horse. White Lightning will bleach hair and clothing.
- Top up the boot with water – to be filled below the coronary band.
- Seal the soak boot securely. The boot must be sealed at the top to avoid the active gases escaping. If using a soak bag, use duct tape to also add strength to the bottom of the bag.
- Soak for 30-40 minutes

We recommend regular treatments (4-6 weekly) until the cavity has grown out and there is no sign of seedy toe left. This helps to reduce the likelihood of re-infection of the area and to allow the new horn to replace the compromised hoof.

Regular hoof trimming is also important for the long term prevention of seedy toe.

Warnings: Do not mix any other product with White Lightning. White Lightning may discolour hair or clothing.
